

## Mission Trip Fundraising Options

1. **Support Letters:** These have been created for you to use and send out. We ask that you send out at least TEN letters. You will also have access to the original copy of these letters if you would like to edit them for your families. We simply ask that you send these letters out to family and friends OUTSIDE of the church. Church members already contribute to our Oxygen budget as well as the Faith Promise budget, which assists us on our trip.

**Note on Support Letters:**

- a) We ask that you only send letters to NON-CROSSING family and friends.
  - b) Pastor Nick will provide specific trip letter, return envelopes & stamps.
  - c) All **financial support** from these letters is **due by Sunday, April 7, 2019.**
  - d) *Feel free to send as many letters to friends/family outside of church.*
2. **Student Employment:** Students, this is YOUR trip. You are highly encouraged to get a job now (or continue in your current employment) to help pay for this trip. A job that pays at minimum wage, where you work 10 hours a week, would equate to roughly \$240 a month (totaling \$1,680 by May).  
*Job Options:* Chick-fil-A in Newtown, other small business, etc.  
*Ask yourself:* What am I good at and how can I market that?  
Pet sitting, dog walking, babysitting, lawn care, snow shoveling, etc.
  3. **Online Fundraising:** Set up a *gofundme* account to share details about your trip, as well as raise prayer and financial support.
  4. **Percentage of Gifts:** Students, ask for a portion of your birthday and/or Christmas gifts to go towards paying for your trip.
  5. **Sell your stuff online:** Get rid of your junk around the house using apps like Letgo and [www.ebay.com](http://www.ebay.com).
